Program Cost

After School Adventures

- * Tues./Thurs. [Elective Classes](#) are \$60.00 per month for 8 sessions.
- * [Choir](#) is a three-month class for \$180.00.
- * After School Adventures fee will be added to your monthly tuition bill.

Scheduling:

1. Your child(ren) will proceed with normal After School Care (ASC) Program check-in and check-out procedures.
2. They will eat the normal provided snack in Mrs. McGovern's Room (room 243).
3. At 3:30 your ASA teacher will pick up your child(ren) and proceed to their class.
4. At 4:30 the ASA teacher will bring their students back to Mrs. McGovern's room (room 243).
5. You as parents will then proceed with normal After School Care Program check-out procedures.

3. Tues/Thurs Elective classes run from 3:30-4:30 with childcare provided between 3:00-3:30

* Special Event schedules (if necessary) will be communicated to parents and students by individual After School Adventure instructors.

Check Out Procedures:

1. Mon./Wed. students will be signed out from room 225 (Mrs. Belloni) between 4:30-4:40.
2. Late pick-up will take place in room 243 (After School Care) where you will sign out your child(ren) with Mrs. McGovern
3. Only parents and siblings (7th grade or older) will be allowed to sign out students unless written permission has been requested and granted by Mr. Mondeel, the program coordinator.
4. There will be a \$10 late pick up fee for those who are picked up 10 minutes late or more. Timely pick up allows program facilitators to go back to their teaching or personal duties on time. This fee does NOT apply to students enrolled in After School Care.

After School Care and After School Adventures Alignment:

Scheduling:

1. Your child(ren) will proceed with normal After School Care (ASC) Program check-in and check-out procedures.
2. They will eat the normal provided snack in Mrs. McGovern's Room (room 243).
3. At 3:15 Mrs. McGovern will dismiss the Choir students to Mrs. Belloni's classroom.
4. At 4:30 the After School Adventure teacher will dismiss the ASC students back to Mrs. McGovern's room (room 243).
5. You as parents will then proceed with normal After School Care Program check-out procedures.
6. The \$10 late pick up fee will NOT apply to After School Care children participating in ASA.

After School Care Costs:

Program Costs for *Full-time* After School Care (ASC) Students:

3. Students will be under proper supervision between 2:45-3:15 by Grace Faculty.

Check Out Procedures:

1. Mon./Wed. students will be signed out from room 225 (Mrs. Belloni) between 4:30-4:40.
2. Late pick-up will take place in room 243 (After School Care) where you will sign out your child(ren) with Mrs. McGovern
3. Only parents and siblings (7th grade or older) will be allowed to sign out students unless written permission has been requested and granted by Mr. Mondeel, the program coordinator.
4. There will be a \$10 late pick up fee for those who are picked up 10 minutes late or more. Timely pick up allows program facilitators to go back to their teaching or personal duties on time. This fee does NOT apply to students enrolled in After School Care.

Program Costs for Students:

1. Each month long After School Adventure class consisting of 8 sessions will cost \$60.00. However, choir is considered a 3 month class thus totaling \$180.00
2. You will be billed according to your request; either three separate times at \$60.00 or one time at \$180.00
3. All class fees are **non-refundable**
