# Academic Program & Advanced Placement

Graduation requires twenty-two credits plus bible classes. High school students follow a modified block schedule, attending classes on Mondays for 50 minutes and on other days for 80 minutes, meeting three times a week throughout the rest of the week. The curriculum is rigorous and college preparatory.
